1. Late Entries will not be accepted.
2. The Judges decision is final.
3. Classes may be amalgamated or separated according to colour/sex dependant on numbers entered.
4. All birds to be penned by 9:30am - Please note, all vehicles must be off of the showground by 8:30am. - and no birds are to be removed from the pens (except for judging purposes) until 5.00 pm.
5. Whilst all care will be taken the show committee accept No responsibility for losses to stock/property whilst at the show. Each exhibitor is responsible for the insurance of stock and equipment brought to the show and no liability shall fall on the show organisers.
6. All birds shown by junior exhibitors will automatically be judged for "Best Juvenile Exhibit".
7. Junior exhibitors must be aged 16 years or under.
8. All stock entered for show/sale should be free from parasites and visible signs of disease.
9. The organisers reserve the right to exclude any birds failing to comply with the above.
10. Any stock entered for sale should be the sole property of the vendor.
11. All prices must be clearly displayed on the cages.
12. All sales will be completed by the show and will be subject to a £2.00 per cage entry fee.
13. All birds for sale must be entered prior to the closing date for the show.
14. The Committee will not accept entries for any young stock which still require artificial heat.
15. There will be a limit of 4 birds per cage in the sale section. Size and age of the birds must be given on the sale entry form.
16. Sellers must provide box's for their sale entries.
17. Picture/drawing entries must be no larger than A4 in size, photographs must be no large than A5 in size.
